Please register if you are not sure if you already have.

Registering online is quick and easy. Doing so now will ensure your child is placed on the proper bus for the first day of school. Not registering on time

could delay having your child assigned a bus several days into the new school year.

Students who will be in grades 6 – 9 in the 2025-2026 school year are welcome to sign up for one, two, three or four sports.
