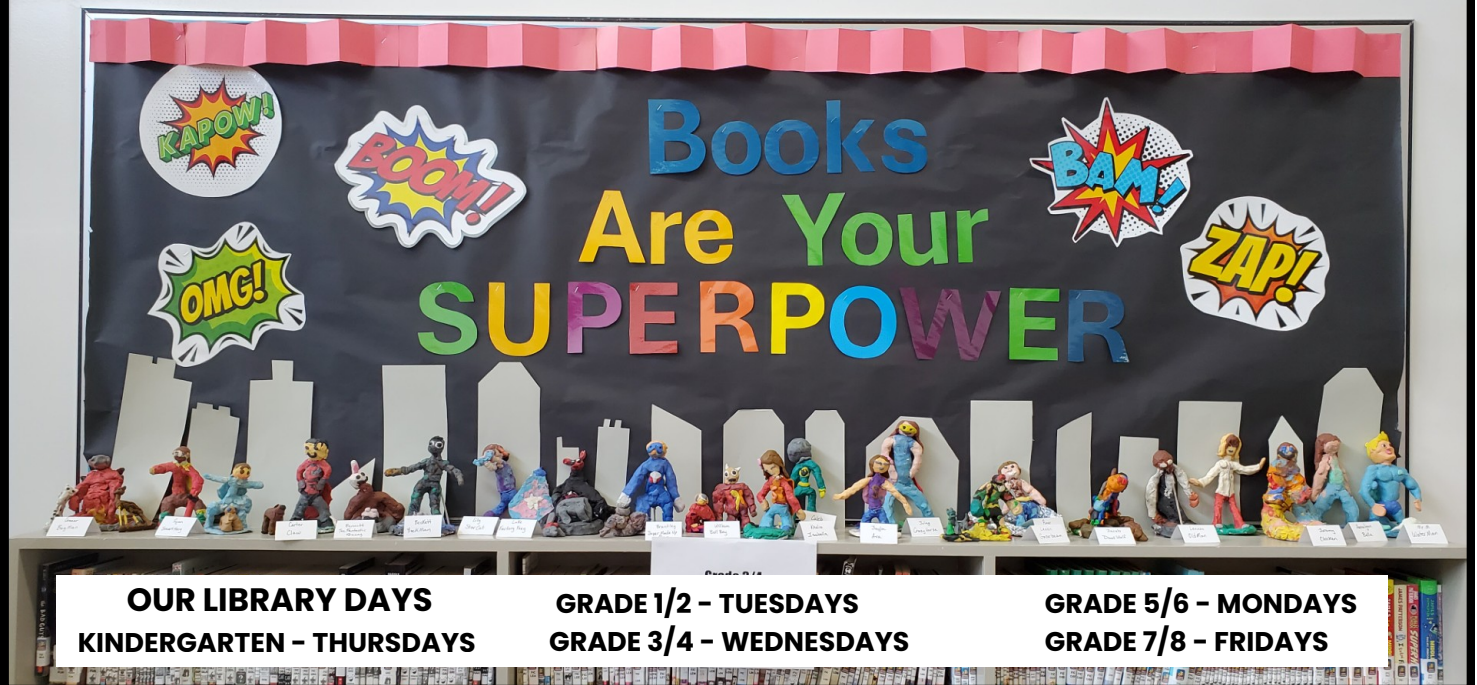
We encourage families to support reading at home by setting aside time each day for independent reading. Regular reading helps build vocabulary, comprehension, and a lifelong love of learning.
